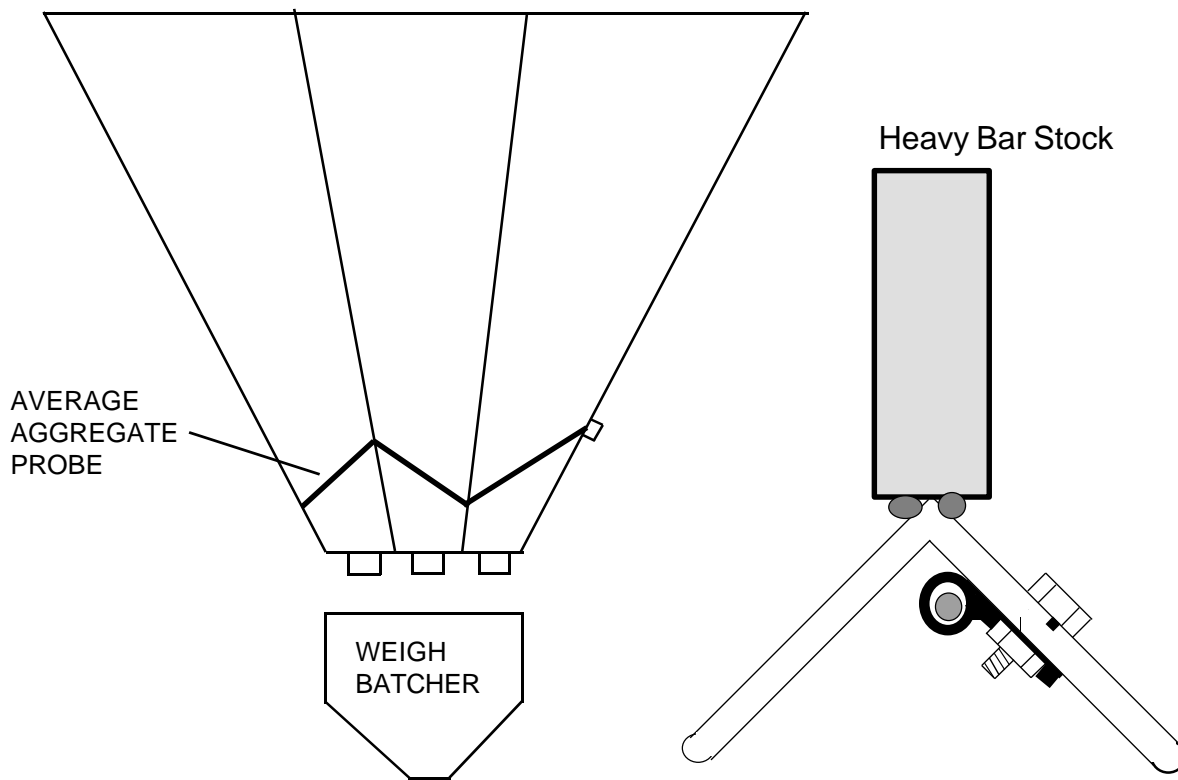

The Average Aggregate Temperature Monitor is a low cost "real time" thermometer. It is easy to install and does not need to be calibrated. The 24 foot long averaging probe mounts in the overhead bins and can be proportioned in the sand and stone bins to give the batch operator a true indication of the next batches aggregate temperature. The Average Aggregate Temperature Monitor can control the aggregate heaters in the bins by means of the optional set point control. This allows for hands off operation and consistent concrete temperatures. Includes Meter, probe and signal cable.

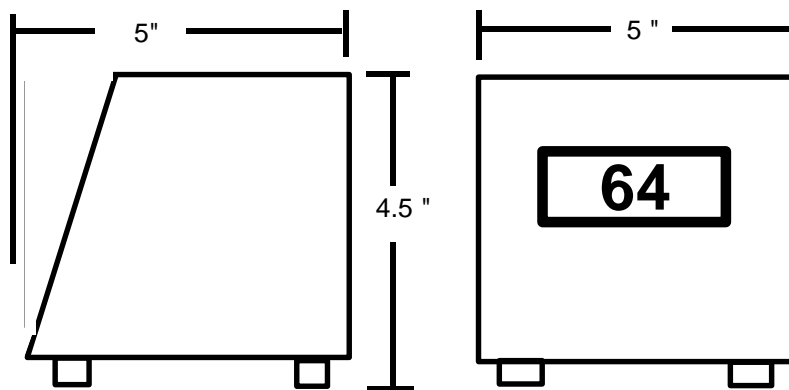
